Description:

The Wound Care Link Nurse Program is a Providence Health Care program. The workshop reviews current best practice related to skin and wound care. Workshop "A" covers foundational information, focusing on Wound Prevention, Risk Assessment, Wound & Skin Assessment, and Wound Treatment using current wound care products and technologies. The class format includes lectures, videos, case studies and discussion.
