

Wound Care Link Nurse – Workshop B Registration Form

Description:

The Wound Care Link Nurse Program is a Providence Health Care program. The workshops review current best practice related to skin and wound care. The focus of **Workshop “B”** is Venous Leg Ulcers, Arterial Ulcers and Diabetic Foot Ulcers. Underlying etiology, assessment and intervention will be reviewed. The class format includes lectures, videos, case studies and discussion. Upon completion, the participant “Wound Care Link Nurses” may act as a front-line resource to other staff who require assistance with leg ulcer issues.

Target Audience:

Workshop B is primarily designed for nurses from all clinical areas, including RN’s, RPN’s and LPN’s. Other disciplines are welcome to attend. Workshop B builds on the concepts from Workshop A. Although not a pre-requisite, it is preferable that the workshops are completed in sequence to enhance learning.

Student nurses may attend however Workshop A is a pre-requisite.
